

Accommodation options

Students declare type of accommodation in application form:

- student dormitories owned by the University (only twin rooms)
- private accommodation (private dormitories or private rooms/apartments)

More information

Accommodation equipment (University dormitories)

The rooms have furniture, bedding and blankets. The rooms have Internet cable connection available but there are no computers. The dormitories have kitchens equipped with fridges and ovens but there are no cooking pans nor dishes.

Approximate cost of accommodation per month

University's dormitories – **450 – 500 PLN** (105 - 115 Euro) Private room - 800 – 1200 PLN (185 - 280 Euro) Private studio/apartment – 1500 - 2000 PLN (350 - 470 Euro)

Booking procedure

Exchange students apply for accommodation in University's dormitories through application form. Confirmation of getting a place is sent in July/December by International Relations Office.

Poznań University of Economics and Business does not act as an intermediary in the rental of private accommodation. Student should contact the chosen institution/landlord independently.

Pick-up service upon arrival/ Buddy System

The student mentors arranged by ESN UE Poznań meet the exchange students on arrival and provide support at the beginning of their stay in Poznań.

Trips to other Polish cities, social events and sport activities are organised by ESN UE Poznań student association.
