Safety and Health	European Health Insurance Card, compulsory for all EU students (except Turkish). A private health policy is recommended for non-European students. The UAc offers an student insurance to all exchange students by paying a fee (3.08€). It's mandatory.
Immigration Requirements	EU students (except Turkish): identity card or Passport. Non-European and Turkish students must arrive with a student visa. The visa request must consider the duration of the mobility (1 semester or 1 year). Upon arrival (in the first three days), Non-European and Turkish students must go to SEF (border services).
