Required documents:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Application form with a picture completed in computer. Form 2. Nomination letter to Yadira Isela Márquez González, MBA. Cooperation and International Office Deputy Head. 3. Transcript of courses/records signed and authorized by your home institution -Translated into Spanish. 4. Copy of Official Identification. 5. Statement of purpose, where the student provides an explanation of his interest for participating in the program - Translated into Spanish. 6. Current Curriculum Vitae – Translated into Spanish. 7. An academic recommendation letter written by a professor from the home institution– Translated into Spanish. 8. Spanish language test score certificate (B1) for those whose language is different than Spanish. 9. English language test score certificate (B1), just in case certain classes are taught in this language.
