- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the faculty/academy of the University of Zagreb no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving faculty/academy.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

	 APPLICATION DEADLINES 15 May → winter (1st) semester / academic year (starting in October) 10 November → summer (2nd) semester (starting in March) ! Students that require a VISA are strongly advised to apply and send their documents one month prior to the deadline since the Visa application process may take several weeks or even months.
Areas of study / courses	Students are allowed to enrol in programs / courses offered by UNIZG faculties / academies, respecting their specific requirements (course pre-requisites, areas of study arranged through institutional agreements with UNIZG etc.).
