LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Language Requirements	The recommendation for English and German language proficiency are depending on the study programme. Please visit our website for exchange students for detailed information.
German Intensive Course	The University's Language Centre offers a three-week German intensive language course (60h) which takes place before the semester starts and is obligatory for exchange students with German language skills below B1 CEFR . The German Intensive Course is <u>free of charge</u> for exchange students. More information can be found on the website of the Language Center .

ACCOMMODATION

Student Dormitory	The university does not have its own accommodation. The International Office offers support in finding accommodation. However, the "Studierendenwerk Thüringen" is in charge for the allocation of places in student dormitories.
