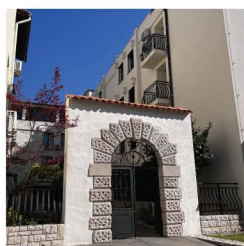
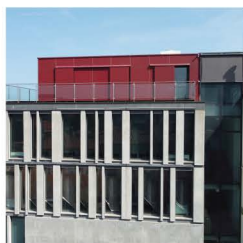
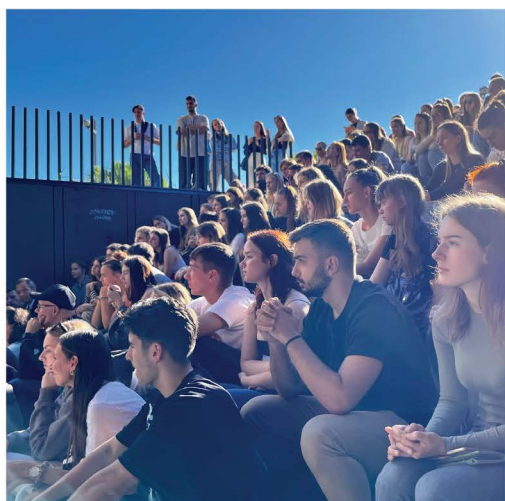

Grading system and grade distribution table: Student performance is graded on a scale of 10 (Excellent) to 5-1 (Fail). A passing grade for an exam is achieved with a score ranging from 6 to 10.

7 (Good)	D (Satisfactory)	Good knowledge, but with major errors.
6 (Poor)	E (Sufficient)	Knowledge which meets the minimum criteria.
5 - 1 (Unsatisfactory)	F, FX (Fail)	Knowledge which does not meet the minimum criteria.
