### Application procedure and requirements

Nomination Deadline Semester A	Application Deadline Semester A
April 1 – April 15th	May 1 <sup>st</sup>
Nomination Deadline Semester B	Application Deadline Semester B
September 1st	October 1 <sup>st</sup>

Students must be nominated by their home university. Nominated students will receive an e-mail from the Departmental International coordinator to start the application in our online system.

EER students do not have to submit a language test if they fill out Annex 2 of the application form. Non EER Students should submit proof of English proficiency unless they have one of the nationalities of one of the following countries: Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, UK and USA.

### Accommodation

Students applying for housing via TU/e are offered a housing contract with a fixed period of one semester regardless of their actual period of stay. TU/e can only guarantee housing for a limited number of exchange students.
