	<p>A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the end of the exam period.</p> <p>Students' performance may be assessed in various ways. Information about these is provided in the Course Unit description. In most cases, students are assessed by way of a final, usually oral, exam.</p> <p>For both written and oral exams, in the Italian grading system students are graded according to a scale ranging from 0 to 30, with 18 as a passing mark.
