	A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the end of the exam period.		
	Students' performance may be assessed in various ways. Information about these is provided in the Course Unit description. In most cases, students are assessed by way of a final, usually oral, exam.		
	For both written and oral exams, in the Italian grading system students are graded according to a scale ranging from 0 to 30, with 18 as a passing mark. A <i>cum laude</i> may be added to the highest grade (30 e lode) as a special distinction. The lowest
