

Health Insurance



Exchange students are required to have a valid health insurance that is equivalent to the German statutory health insurance, i.e. unlimited coverage of all treatments (incl. dental, psychological and pregnancy care) for the whole duration of their stay.

EU-Nationals: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is sufficient.

Non-EU Nationals: German health insurance is available for about 70-90 € per month at numerous German health insurance providers (for example, [CareConcept](#))

Please note that an additional travel insurance might be necessary for the time gap between departure of the home country and the first day of the semester.

Public Transportation



Students are required to pay fees for a semester ticket (approx. 200 €) for the local public transport network. This includes the Regionalbahn, S-Bahn and all BVG-operated vehicles (U-Bahn, buses, trams, ferries) within all of Germany. The ticket is valid for the whole semester (six months).

Registration of Residence



All incoming students have to register their residence at one of Berlin's Registration Office within two weeks after arrival to get a confirmation of registration (in German: [Meldebestätigung](#)).
