Welcome and Orientation Session

Language Requirements:

Courses in English: Recommended level B2 in English

Courses in Turkish: Recommended level B2 in Turkish (TÖMER)

B2 level is expected for all exchange students following English-taught courses.

Turkish Language Support

The university offers optional Turkish Language Courses during the semester for incoming international students. These courses are designed to help students improve their communication skills and better integrate into daily life in Türkiye.

Free Turkish support classes (basic level) may be offered each semester

3. Academic Preparation

3.1. MEBİS

Students at Istanbul Medipol University can use MEBİS System to Access their student information and do their course selection.

Before coming to Istanbul Medipol University, exchange students should select the courses they wish to attend using the course catalogue available on our website:

The course catalogue is published yearly. Autumn Semester applicants must base their course selection on courses offered in the previous academic year and adjust their choices accordingly.

The academic advisors at Istanbul Medipol University may suggest amendments and will approve the final selection.

4. Visa and Residence Permit

Non-EU Citizens: Non-EU students may require a visa to enter Turkey. Students should contact the nearest Turkish Embassy before their intended arrival to inquire about the visa application process.

Students should also request a residency permit from the Turkish Presidency of Migration Management after arriving in Turkey, by regular mail.

EU and EFTA Citizens:

EU and EFTA citizens do not need a visa to enter Turkey, but they will need to apply for a Student residence permit once they arrive.

5. Housing

Finding accommodation in Istanbul can be challenging and expensive. Istanbul Medipol University provides housing support to students, but there is no guarantee of housing for all applications.

6. Cost of Living in Istanbul

The average cost of living for a student in Istanbul is approximately approximately 800-1000 Euro per month. This includes rent, food, health insurance and other basic necessities.

7. Insurance

Health insurance is mandatory in Turkey. Students may request the recognition of their private health insurance or subscribe to a student insurance plan upon arrival. The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is recognized in Turkey for health and accident insurance.

8. Transcript of Records

A Transcript of Records will be issued after the assessment period ends at the University. The transcript will be sent by the Faculties to the student's address in their home country.

9. Grading system

Istanbul Medipol University uses a grading scale ranging from 0 to 4.00, with 2.00 representing a passing grade. Furthermore, grades are converted into a letter system ranging from A to F

(the ECTS scale), in line with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). This conversion facilitates comparison across different European grading systems.
